1. RENEWABLY SOURCED LPG ("BIOLPG") AT SCALE IS NECESSARY

- 1.1. For many well-evidenced reasons, increased use of LPG for cooking is a goal of many Governments, including India.
- 1.2. LPG is a proven ecosystem of policies, regulations, market practices, reliable supply at scale, infrastructure and affordable consumer equipment.
- 1.3. LPG presently is a fossil energy, but markets would welcome green LPG at scale, enabling them to support national green transition ambitions/schedules.
- 1.4. COOL LPG, a US breakthrough in catalytic reforming, has demonstrated the possibility of BioLPG production at scale from biogas or syngas.
- 1.5. Use of the latent energy in wastes is a circular economy activity that could valorize huge Indian waste resources -both urban and rural and reduce the need for import of LPG from the volatile global fossil LPG market.



2. A CONCEPTUAL ROADMAP OF HOW BIOLPG CAN BE DEVELOPED

- 2.1. Assess feedstock potential.
- 2.2. Aggregate and coordinate relevant stakeholders.
- 2.3. Coordinate with National, State and Local Government.
- 2.4. Conduct the sequence of relevant studies and preparation: pre-feasibility, feasibility and project preparation.
- 2.5. Properly prepare finance markets: commercial/investment/development banks, insurance companies, state funding.
